

Introduction to Youth Participation

One day course (9.30am to 4.30pm)

Course Summary:

- Demonstrate an understanding of what youth participation is
- Identify barriers to youth participation which may exist in their organisation, and some of the solutions which may work in their setting
- Indicate a knowledge of practical tools for youth participation which can apply to the organisation
